

Reversible Festive Place Mats & Napkins



Reversible Festive Place Mats

16 x 18-inches

Fabrics and Supplies to make 6 place mats

1-1/4 yards **GREEN PINE PRINT** for top
1-5/8 yards **LARGE RED ROSE FLORAL** for top
2 yards **"PATCHWORK" PRINT** for backing
1 yard **RED STRIPE** for binding
quilt batting (6) 21 x 23-inch rectangles

Cutting

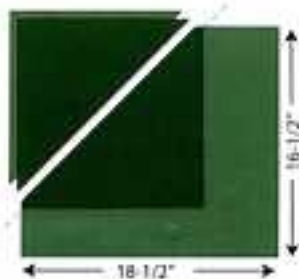
From **GREEN PINE PRINT**:

- Cut 3, 14-1/2 x 44-inch strips. From strips cut:
6, 14-1/2-inch squares

From **LARGE RED ROSE FLORAL**:

- Cut 3, 16-1/2 x 44-inch strips. From strips cut:
6, 16-1/2 x 18-1/2-inch rectangles

Piecing - With right sides together, position a 14-1/2-inch **GREEN PINE PRINT** rectangle on the upper left corner of a 16-1/2 x 18-1/2-inch **LARGE RED ROSE FLORAL** rectangle. Draw a diagonal line on the square; stitch on the line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4-inch; press.
At this point each place mat top should measure 16-1/2 x 18-1/2-inches.



Putting It All Together

Cutting

From **"PATCHWORK" PRINT**:

- Cut 3, 23 x 44-inch strips. From strips cut:
6, 21 x 23-inch backing rectangles

Refer to **Finishing the Quilt** on page 39 for complete finishing instructions. Our place mats were quilted with an allover meander design.

Binding

From **RED STRIPE**:

- Cut 12, 2-3/4 x 44-inch strips. Diagonally piece 2 strips together for each place mat.

Sew binding to place mats using a 3/8-inch seam allowance. This measurement will produce a 1/2-inch wide finished double binding. Refer to **Binding and Diagonal Piecing** on page 39 for complete instructions.

Napkins

Fabrics and Supplies to make 6 napkins

1-5/8 yards **"PATCHWORK" PRINT #1** for napkin top
1-5/8 yards **"PATCHWORK" PRINT #2** for napkin backing

Cutting

From **"PATCHWORK" PRINT #1**:

- Cut 3, 18-1/2 x 44-inch strips. From strips cut:
6, 18-1/2-inch squares

From **"PATCHWORK" PRINT #2**:

- Cut 3, 18-1/2 x 44-inch strips. From strips cut:
6, 18-1/2-inch squares

Assembly

Step 1 With right sides together, layer the 18-1/2-inch **"PATCHWORK" PRINT #1** and **#2** squares in pairs. Sew the squares together with a 1/4-inch seam allowance leaving 4-inches open for turning.

Step 2 Turn napkins right side out; press. Stitch opening closed. Topstitch 1/4-inch from the edges of each napkin.
