# Apple Stand Table Runner

## Fabrics & Supplies

### September Apple Block

1/8 yard GOLD PRINT for apples

1/8 yard MEDIUM GREEN PRINT for apples

1/8 yard RED PRINT for apples

1/8 yard DARK GREEN PRINT for leaves

1/8 yard BROWN PRINT for stems

1/4 yard BEIGE PRINT for background

### Borders, Binding, Backing

1/4 yard BEIGE PRINT

for inner border, pieced border

1/4 yard DARK GREEN PRINT for pieced border

1/4 yard GOLD FLORAL for outer border

1/4 yard GOLD FLORAL for binding

2/3 yard for backing

quilt batting, at least 24 x 30-inches

Make the **SEPTEMBER APPLE BLOCK** using the **Cutting and Piecing** instructions on pages 104 - 105.

*When the Apple Block is complete it should measure 12-1/2-inches square.*

## Borders

**Note:** Yardage given allows for border strips to be cut on crosswise grain. Read through **Border** instructions on page 139 for general instructions on adding borders.

### Cutting

From **BEIGE PRINT**:

- Cut 2, 1-1/2 x 44-inch inner border strips
- Cut 1, 1-1/2 x 44-inch strip. From strip cut: 28, 1-1/2-inch squares

From **DARK GREEN PRINT**:

- Cut 3, 1-1/2 x 44-inch strips. From strips cut: 28, 1-1/2 x 3-1/2-inch rectangles

From **GOLD FLORAL**:

- Cut 2, 2-1/2 x 44-inch outer border strips
- Cut 1, 1-1/2 x 44-inch strip. From strip cut: 28, 1-1/2-inch squares

## Attaching Borders

**Step 1** Attach 1-1/2-inch wide **BEIGE** inner border strips to the **APPLE BLOCK**; press.

**Step 2** With right sides together, position a 1-1/2-inch **BEIGE** square on the corner of a 1-1/2 x 3-1/2-inch **DARK GREEN** rectangle. Draw a diagonal line on the square; stitch on the line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4-inch; press. Position a 1-1/2-inch **GOLD FLORAL** square on the opposite corner of the rectangle. Draw a diagonal line on the square; stitch on the line, trim, and press.



Make 28

**Step 3** For the top/bottom pieced borders, sew together (14) Step 2 units; press. At this point each pieced border should measure 3-1/2 x 14-1/2-inches. Sew the pieced borders to the top/bottom edges of the quilt center; press.



Make 2 pieced borders

**Step 4** Attach 2-1/2-inch wide **GOLD FLORAL** outer border strips.

## Putting It All Together

Trim batting and backing so they are 6-inches larger than the quilt top. Refer to **Finishing the Quilt** on page 140 for complete instructions.

### Quilting Suggestions:

- **BEIGE** background-stipple
- Apples-circular design, in-the-ditch
- **GREEN** pieced border-in-the-ditch
- **GOLD FLORAL**-small meander

## Binding

### Cutting

From **GOLD FLORAL**:

- Cut 3, 2-3/4 x 44-inch strips

Sew binding to quilt using a 3/8-inch seam allowance. This measurement will produce a 1/2-inch wide finished double binding. Refer to **Binding and Diagonal Piecing** on page 140 for complete instructions.
