Bubble Woolie Pillow



Fabrics & Supplies

Finished Size: 18-inches square

Note: Extra yardage is allowed so the wool can be felted (prewashed). 100% wool can shrink up to 20% in width and length; a wool blend will shrink less. To avoid future shrinkage upon completion of your wool appliqué project, dry cleaning is recommended.

- 10-inch square **BLACK WOOL** for circles
- 14-inch square GOLD WOOL for circles
- 10-inch square GREEN WOOL for circles
- 1-1/4 yards **STRIPE PRINT** for pillow top and pillow back
- 18-inch square pillow form
- BLACK and GOLD No.8 pearl cotton for decorative stitches
- freezer paper for appliqués
- template material (template plastic or cardstock)
- small, sharp scissors
- No. 7 embroidery needle
- 3/4-inch sequin pins (optional)
- fabric glue (optional)

Before beginning this project, read through General Instructions for Wool Appliqué on page 76 for complete instructions on how to prepare the wool and appliqué shapes.

Bubble Woolie Pillow

Cutting

From STRIPE PRINT:

- Cut 1, 25 x 44-inch strip. From strip cut:
 2, 18-1/2 x 25-inch rectangles for pillow back
- Cut 1, 18-1/2-inch square for pillow top (appliqué foundation)

From BLACK WOOL:

- Cut 3, F Circles
- Cut 2, G Circles
- Cut 1, H Circle

From GOLD WOOL:

- Cut 6, E Circles
- Cut 3, F Circles
- Cut 1, G Circle


From GREEN WOOL:

- Cut 4, F Circles
- Cut 3, G Circles
- Cut 1, H Circle

Wool Appliqué

Step 1 Mark a 2-inch border on all 4 sides of the 18-1/2-inch STRIPE pillow top square.


The marked border will serve as a guide when placing circles.



Step 2 Referring to the photograph on page 54 for placement, position the prepared wool circles on the pillow top. Blanket stitch circles in place with pearl cotton. Refer to *General Instructions for Wool Appliqué* on page 76 for complete instructions on appliquéing the circles in place.

Pillow Back

Step 1 With wrong sides together, fold each pillow back rectangle in half crosswise to make 2, 12-1/2 x 18-1/2-inch double-thick pillow back pieces. Overlap the 2 folded edges so pillow back measures 18-1/2-inches square. Pin pieces together and machine baste around entire piece using a 1/4-inch seam allowance to create a single pillow back.



Step 2 With right sides together, layer the pillow back and the prepared pillow top; pin. Stitch around outside edges using a 1/2-inch seam allowance. Turn pillow cover right side out.

Make sure corners are pushed out and square. Insert pillow form through back opening.
