

Bar Code Runner



Make this runner in just minutes! That's all the time it takes to make this showy, quick and oh so easy runner. Make it in many combinations to use throughout the year. It is also perfect for a lovely housewarming gift. Combine with a bottle of wine or candles for an impressive gift.



Fabrics and Supplies

- 5/8 yard **LARGE GREEN/GOLD FLORAL** for runner top
- 1/4 yard **RUST PRINT** for runner top
- 1/4 yard **GOLD/BEIGE FLORAL** for runner top
- 1/8 yard **BROWN PRINT** for runner top
- 3/8 yard **GREEN PRINT** for binding
- 1/2 yards **GOLD/BEIGE FLORAL** for backing
- quilt batting, at least 24 x 54-inches

Runner Top

Cutting

From **LARGE GREEN/GOLD FLORAL**:

- Cut 1, 18-1/2 x 44-inch strip. From strip cut:
 - 1, 12-1/2 x 18-1/2-inch center rectangle
 - 2, 6-1/2 x 18-1/2-inch rectangles

From **RUST PRINT**:

- Cut 2, 2-1/2 x 44-inch strips. From strips cut:
 - 4, 2-1/2 x 18-1/2-inch rectangles

From **GOLD/BEIGE FLORAL**:

- Cut 1, 6-1/2 x 44-inch strip. From strip cut:
 - 2, 6-1/2 x 18-1/2-inch rectangles

From **BROWN PRINT**:

- Cut 1, 2-1/2 x 44-inch strip. From strip cut:
 - 2, 2-1/2 x 18-1/2-inch rectangles

Piecing - Referring to diagram for placement, sew rectangles together; press. At this point the runner top should measure 18-1/2 x 48-1/2-inches.



Putting It All Together

Trim batting and backing so they are 6-inches larger than runner top. Refer to **Finishing the Quilt** on page 39 for complete instructions.

Quilting Suggestions:

- **RUST** bands - **TB64 - 1-1/2" Nordic Scroll**
- **BROWN** bands - **TB93 - 1-1/2" M-Border**
- **GOLD/BEIGE FLORAL** bands - **TB70 - 5" Tuscan Vine**
- **LARGE GREEN/GOLD FLORAL** bands - outline stitch the floral motifs, stipple in dark green background

Binding

Cutting

From **GREEN PRINT**:

- Cut 4, 2-3/4 x 44-inch strips

Sew binding to quilt using a 3/8-inch seam allowance. This measurement will produce a 1/2-inch wide finished double binding. Refer to **Binding** and **Diagonal Piecing** on page 39 for complete instructions.
