## **Fabrics and Supplies**

- 1-1/8 yards **BEIGE PRINT** for blocks
- 5/8 yard **BROWN PRINT** for blocks, border 1
- 1-1/2 yards **GREEN PRINT #1** for blocks, border 2
- 3/8 yard YELLOW-RED FLORAL for blocks
- 1 yard **RED PRINT #1** for blocks
- 7/8 yard **GREEN PRINT #2** for alternate blocks
- 1-1/4 yards **BEIGE FLORAL** for side/corner triangles
- 1-1/4 yards **RED PRINT #2** for borders 3 and 5
- 5-1/8 yards LARGE MULTICOLOR FLORAL for borders 4 and 6
- 7/8 yard **RED PRINT #2** for binding
- 8 yards backing fabric
- quilt batting, at least 94 x 111-inches



## PAINTED DAISY SECTION I

## **Getting Started**

- If concerned about colorfastness, test a 2-inch square of fabric in warm water to see if dye is released. If so, prewash and press the fabric.
- If concerned about shrinkage, prewash and press all the fabric.
- Read instructions thoroughly before beginning the project.
- For piecing, place right sides of fabric pieces together and use 1/4-inch seam allowances throughout unless otherwise specified.
- It is necessary that accurate 1/4-inch seam allowances are used. It is wise to stitch a sample 1/4-inch seam allowance to check your machine's seam allowance accuracy.
- Seam allowances are included in the cutting sizes given.
- Press seam allowances in one direction toward the darker fabric and/or in the direction that will create the least bulk.

### Painted Daisy Blocks - Makes 12

#### Cutting

#### From **BEIGE PRINT**:

- Cut 11, 1-1/2 x 42-inch strips. From strips cut: 48, 1-1/2 x 3-1/2-inch rectangles 48, 1-1/2 x 2-1/2-inch rectangles 96, 1-1/2 -inch squares
- •Cut 6, 2-1/2 x 42-inch strips. From strips cut: 96, 2-1/2-inch squares

#### From **BROWN PRINT**:

•Cut 3, 2-1/2 x 42-inch strips. From strips cut: 48, 2-1/2-inch squares

#### From **GREEN PRINT** #1:

- •Cut 8, 2-1/2 x 42-inch strips. From strips cut: 48, 2-1/2 x 3-1/2-inch rectangles 48, 2-1/2-inch squares
- •Cut 4, 1-1/2 x 42-inch strips. From strips cut: 96, 1-1/2-inch squares

#### From **YELLOW-RED FLORAL**:

•Cut 4, 2-1/2 x 42-inch strips. From strips cut: 60, 2-1/2-inch squares

#### From **RED PRINT #1**:

- •Cut 9, 2-1/2 x 42-inch strips. From strips cut: 96, 2-1/2 x 3-1/2-inch rectangles
- •Cut 4, 1-1/2 x 42-inch strips. From strips cut: 96, 1-1/2-inch squares

**Piecing** - Refer to arrows on diagrams for pressing.

**Step 1** With a pencil draw diagonal line on wrong side of each 1-1/2-inch **GREEN #1** square. With right sides together, position marked **GREEN #1** square on the corner of a 2-1/2-inch **BROWN** square. Stitch on line, trim seam allowance to 1/4-inch, and press. Repeat this process at adjacent corner of **BROWN** square. At this point each unit should measure 2-1/2-inches square.


**Step 2** With a pencil draw diagonal line on wrong side of each 1-1/2-inch **RED #1** square. With right sides together, position marked **RED #1** square on the corner of a 2-1/2-inch **GREEN #1** square. Stitch on line, trim seam allowance to 1/4-inch, and press. Repeat this process at adjacent corner of **GREEN #1** square. At this point each unit should measure 2-1/2-inches square.

**Step 3** Sew Step 1 units to top/bottom edges of 2-1/2 **YELLOW-RED FLORAL** squares; press. Make 12 units. Sew Step 2 units to side edges of remaining Step 1 units; press. Make 24 units. Referring to block diagram, sew units together; press. At this point each unit should measure 6-1/2-inches square.

## PAINTED DAISY SECTION I

**Step 4** With a pencil draw diagonal line on wrong side of each 1-1/2-inch **BEIGE** square. With right sides together, position marked **BEIGE** square on the corner of a 2-1/2 x 3-1/2-inch **GREEN** #1 rectangle. Stitch on line, trim seam allowance to 1/4-inch, and press. Repeat this process at adjacent corner of **GREEN** #1 rectangle. At this point each unit should measure 2-1/2 x 3-1/2-inches.

**Step 5** With a pencil draw diagonal line on wrong side of each 2-1/2-inch **BEIGE** square. With right sides together, position marked **BEIGE** square on the corner of a 2-1/2 x 3-1/2-inch **RED** #1 rectangle. Stitch on line, trim seam allowance to 1/4-inch, and press. Repeat this process at adjacent corner of **RED** #1 rectangle. At this point each unit should measure 2-1/2 x 3-1/2-inches.






**Step 6** Referring to diagram for placement, sew Step 5 units to both side edges of Step 4 units; press. At this point each unit should measure 3-1/2 x 6-1/2-inches.

**Step 7** Sew Step 6 units to top/bottom edges of Step 3 units; press.






**Step 8** Sew 1-1/2 x 2-1/2-inch **BEIGE** rectangles to top edge of 2-1/2-inch **YELLOW-RED FLORAL** squares; press. Sew 1-1/2 x 3-1/2-inch **BEIGE** rectangles to left edge of the units; press. <u>At this point each unit should measure 3-1/2-inches square</u>.







**Step 9** Sew Step 8 units to side edges of remaining Step 6 units; press.

**Step 10** Sew Step 9 units to side edges of Step 7 units to complete the Painted Daisy blocks; press. <u>At this point each block should measure 12-1/2-inches square</u>.
